- Connie Skinner-Morris, SAR Secretary, SI-Kent & Queen Anne's Counties, presented the Reading of Official Greetings from Elizabeth "Liz" Lucas, Executive Director and CEO of Soroptimist International of the Americas and Susan "Sam" Collier Buchanan, 2015-2016 SIA President.
- Governor Robin asked all voting delegates to be seated in the front rows and to HOLD UP their delegate card.
- Laura Jones and Betty Ann O'Brien, SAR Board Members, welcomed the members attending conference for their first time and also the members attending who had 30 + years with Soroptimist.

- Pamela Sinclair, SAR Treasurer, announced that the attendees with 30+ years of service represented a total of 572 years of Soroptimist service.
- Linda Blake, SI-Hampton Roads, presented the Preliminary Credentials Report. See page 9 for Preliminary Credentials Report.
  - o It was moved, seconded, and accepted that the Preliminary Credentials Report be approved. Motion carried.
- The Standing Rules for the 2016 Spring Conference were presented by, Parliamentarian LouAnne Hunnicutt.
  - o It was moved, seconded, and accepted that the Standing Rules be approved. Motion carried.
- Connie Skinner-Morris, SAR Secretary, presented the Official Call to Conference. Secretary, Connie Skinner-Morris, moved that the reading of the Official Call to Conference be dispensed, as the Call was sent to all clubs in the region more than forty-five days prior to conference. Motion was seconded and accepted by the voting delegates.
- Pamela Sinclair, SAR Treasurer, moved that the adoption of the Conference Agenda be accepted, plus any modifications as may be necessary to carry out the business of the region. Motion was seconded and accepted by the voting delegates.
- Linda Blake, SI-Hampton Roads, presented the First report of the Credentials Committee. See page 9 for Preliminary Credentials Report. It was moved, seconded, and accepted that the Preliminary Credentials Report be approved. Motion carried.
- Pamela Sinclair, SAR Treasurer, presented the SAR Financial Report. After discussion, the Financial Report was approved and will be filed for audit.
- Governor Robin explained the Consent Agenda. The consent agenda has the Minutes of the 106<sup>th</sup> Spring Conference, the proposed budget for the 2016-2018 Biennium and the Region's Bylaws and Procedures.
- Connie Morris, SAR Secretary, stated that the Minutes of the SAR 106<sup>th</sup> Conference were approved by a committee comprised of:

- Pam Sinclair, SAR Treasurer, Presented the proposed Budget for the 2016-2018 Biennium. The budget is balanced and will be running tight.
- Louise Skinner, Bylaws and Procedures Committee, SI Kent & Queen Anne's Counties, explained the new Region Bylaws and Procedures. She explained they were approved by SIA and the region is in compliance.
- Mollie Flood, SI Alexandria, made a motion to remove the Proposed Budget from the consent agenda, it was seconded. The 2016-2018 Proposed Budget was removed.
- Mollie Flood, SI Alexandria, asked a question about Income excluding \$8,000.00, Governor Robin explained the keeping the cost down the \$8,000.00 is running with a cushion and the extra income was from past years.
- Pat Lynch, SI Raleigh, asked to go through the Budget line by line. Pam Sinclair explained that the budget is for the 2 year period. August Retreat is for 1 year only. Governor's expenses are down. There is no SI Convention this coming biennium so no money was budgeted for it. There was money for the Istanbul convention in the current budget but Robin did not attend. Board expenses and insurance went up. Fall meeting expenses were reduced. Linda Waal, SI Kent and Queen Anne's Counties, asked if there would be a Violet Richardson award in this Biennium. Governor-Elect Amy Harman explained that with the presentation of the proposed budget, the Board was recommending the continuation of the Violet Richardson Award for the next biennium, but with a change that the winners would no longer be attending the conference, so there was no budget line item for travel and meals for such winners. The Region will cut a check and let the winning club present that check to the winner locally. Governor-Elect Amy mentioned that if club participation in the program continued to decline, it would be possible to propose an amendment at the 2017 Conference whereby the award would not be given in 2018, and the money set aside designated for another use, such as the Dream It, Be It program, or the Live Your Dream program.
- Judi Loscomb, SI Talbot, Region Raffle Chair, asked: what if you don't make the money budgeted? Governor Robin explained big items like the Wine Pull goes to each club that participated as Club Giving and Region Bead Sale goes to things like Disaster Relief. Please place new ideas on the evaluation form of places you would like to see the fundraising money to go.
- Cari Corey, SI Talbot, noted that Dream It Be It only has \$500.00 should we raise it? Governor-Elect Amy responded that this startup money is waiting for guidance from SIA on any awards given next year.

- A motion to approve the 2016-2018 Proposed Budget was made and a second was given. Motion carried.
- Governor Robin announced that SI Upper Montgomery County was the winner for South Atlantic Region in the Membership Campaign. The Membership campaign will go on for another year. Good Luck!
